3. <u>Hazards identification</u>	This product is classified as R10 (Flammable) according to EU Directive 1999/45/EC. Eye contact: Transient superficial irritation. Skin contact: Prolonged exposure may cause skin irritation. Ingestion: Possible mild gastro-intestinal irritation with nausea and vomiting. Inhalation: Inhaling aerosolized product may cause mild irritation of the respiratory system.															
4. <u>First-aid measures</u>	Eye contact: Rinse thoroughly with plenty of water for several minutes. If symptoms persist, seek medical advice. Skin contact: Rinse affected area with water. Regular treatment: use 20-80ml (1 to 4 dosing bottle dosages or 1 to 4 dosing pumps) product for 8L of cold water. Mop or spray the product on the floor or apply through a scrubber drier. Buff to increase gloss.

Usage aids

Manual dosing bottle, trigger spray bottle.

Cautionary guidance

Flammable. Rinse hands after use.

Eye contact: In case of contact with eyes, rinse thoroughly with plenty of water for at least 15 minutes. If symptoms persist, seek medical advice.

Skin contact: Rinse affected area thoroughly with water. If needed apply cold compress to relieve irritation. In case any irritation persists, discontinue use of the product and seek medical advice.

Ingestion: In case of ingestion, drink water to dilute product. Do not induce vomiting. Act immediately to prevent further irritation. If symptoms persist, seek medical advice.

Inhalation: If irritation should occur, rinse mouth and throat with water and move to fresh air. If any irritation persists or asthma-like symptoms occur, seek medical advice.
